

## Little Acorn Brown By Kaila Harrell

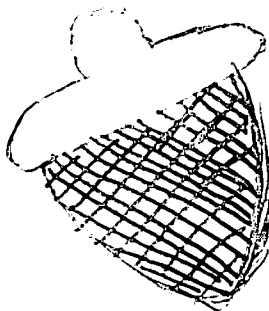

With nothing left to do he began to sing;

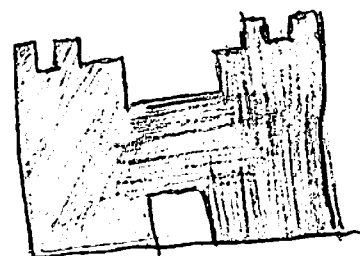
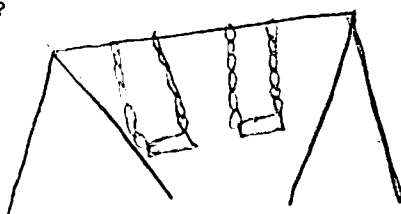
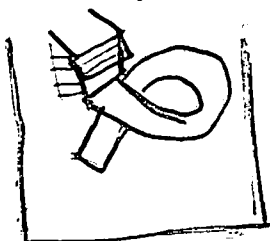

Now you sing it!

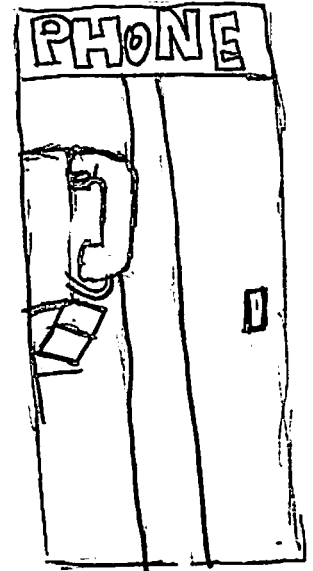

Do you like to take baths?

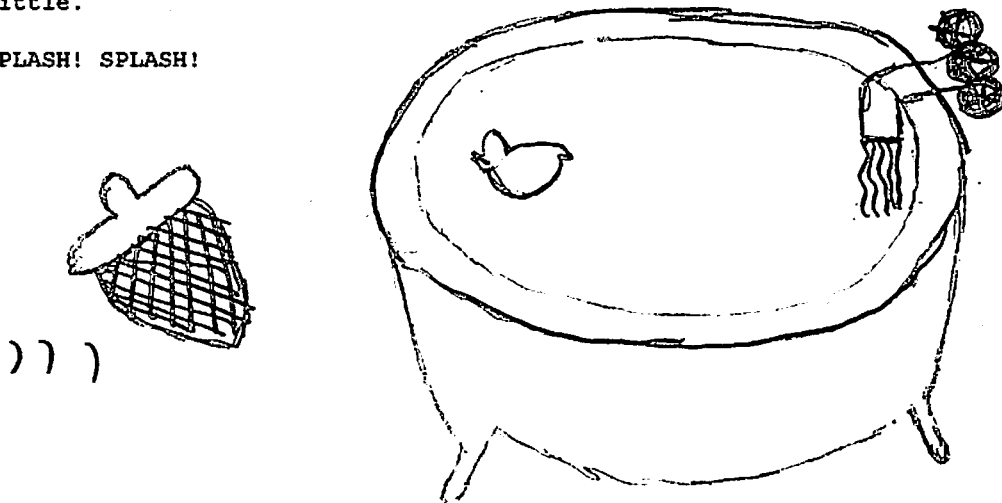
He put some bubbles in his bath then turned his favorite song on called the monkey dance. Before he gets in his bath he always likes to just put one toe in first to test the water. So he did.

Little Acorn Brown went to his favorite movie theatre.

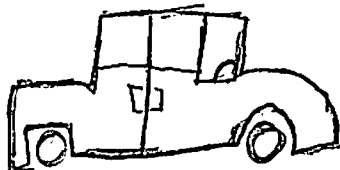
When they got there his mom parked the car and walked with him to the line.

"I will mommy." he replied. Then she left little Acorn Brown at the entrance doors and watched him go in.

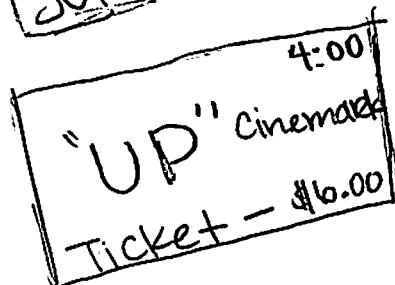
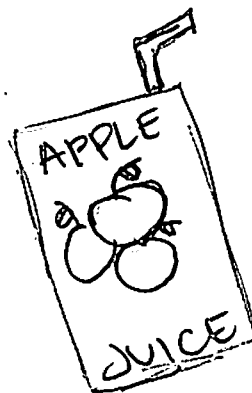
Do you like to go to the movies?
